WHAT'S GOING ON?

We are currently in the beginning stages of a master planning process for the new Eckert Blufflands Park in St. Croix County. Over the next 6 months, we will be seeking ideas and input to determine the vision for this 167-acre open space.

Located in the towns of Hudson and St. Joseph, the new park features wooded bluffs over 100' high along more than 1/2-mile of St. Croix River shoreline. The park will have a natural resource and outdoor recreation focus that could include scenic overlooks, shoreline access and exploration, fishing, picnicking, camping, hiking, snowshoeing, bird watching, hunting and trapping, boat-in access, and other outdoor recreation activities.
