

St. Croix County Recycling Information – Fall of 2012

Fall Special Waste Collection Events

The **Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep** will be a 2-day event and will occur on **Friday, September 14th 1PM – 4PM & Saturday, September 15th 9AM – noon** at the County Highway Shop, 666 Highway 12 East, Hudson. Households and farms with up to 500 pounds of waste are fee-exempt. Small businesses (defined as those generating no more than 200 pounds of waste per month) may participate but will be charged. Farms and businesses must pre-register by September 11th by calling 715-386-4675 for a [pre-registration form](#). Fluorescent bulbs and oil filters will be accepted for a fee. Latex paint and used oil will **not** be accepted. The **County Appliance Collection** will be held on **Saturday, September 15th** at two sites: Glenwood City Recycling Center (8AM -1PM) and Town of Richmond Recycling Center (9AM – 2PM). Prices were lowered this year to \$8 for most appliances this includes, but is not limited to: air conditioners, clothes washers, clothes dryers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, freezers, grills, humidifiers, microwaves, electric/gas ranges, electric/gas stoves, refrigerators, trash compactors, vacuum cleaners and water heaters. Cash and checks will be accepted.

The Recycling Program has changed the way these events are being promoted throughout the county due to a reduction in grant funding from the state. The *Your Wasteline* newsletter will not be sent this fall. Please help us spread the word about the collections to your contacts and friends.
