## **Business:**

- 1. Public Works building specs and progress: no progress at this time. <u>Motion to recommend</u> that the board approve a meeting between Stantec, the Town Chair, a member of the Public Works Committee and a contractor for further discussion regarding this process. Stantec has stated that there would no charge for this meeting. Johnson/Marty-passed
- 2. Sealcoating and cracksealing project for 2017 awarded to Farhner
  - a. Oversee the first sweeping of the sealcoating: we don't want so much leftover gravel. Stantec will watch the application process carefully
- 3. **Paser ratings**: <u>Motion to recommend to the board that Stantec do the Paser Ratings and the</u> WISLR updating. They will bring a price to the board. Johnson/Marty passed
- 4. Change the weight on our weight restriction signs.
  - a. Class"B" weight restrictions: Most municipalities do not have the extra 3 tonnage on the bottom of our signs. Motion to recommend that the board remove the "extra 3 tonnage" on the bottom of our weight restriction signs so that they are all the same since some of the signs have it and some do not. Johnson/Simpson passed This can be done with the removal of a couple of bolts.

Kimball and Long are doing further research on the restriction enforcement.

- 5. **Replacement of tractor and equipment**: We need to look at a way to budget for a new tractor and new mower. They are nearing the end of their lifetime and maintenance costs are increasing. Will put on the next agenda for further discussion.
- 6. **Next major road project**: We will work on this with some scenarios for the board for the next major road project.
- 7. General maintenance:
  - a. Maintenance issues
    - Damages to roads: <u>Recommend that the Town Board go forward with the Red Pine</u>
       <u>Trail replacement project.</u> The Town should have Stantec do the marking for the
       asphalt cuts and oversee the project.
      - Missing ROW signs on 85<sup>th</sup> and a couple of them are bent on 60<sup>th</sup>.
    - ii. Completion of work orders: Some are not completed.
    - iii. Brushing and tree cutting: some still needs to be done.
    - iv. Tractor maintenance
      - 1. Front tractor tires: on next agenda
    - v. Tractor operators and payscale: on next agenda
    - vi. Mower maintenance: was completed
    - vii. Sweeping of roads: done

- viii. Gravel maintenance issues associated with 41st St. and 30th St. (proposals/solutions): on next agenda
- b. Potholing progress:
  - cold mix material from monarch paving: Marty went to Amery to check out the cold mix vs. the popcorn stuff. We will get a 5 yard load and try it out. It is cheaper than the mix from County.
  - 2. time line to do potholes and dig outs on work orders: starting Thursday.
  - ii. Maintenance issues not addressed above: gravel maintenance

- 9. **Review of budget year to date and comparison with previous years.** We reviewed the spreadsheet document.
